# **Privacy Statement**

Kilbraur Windfarm Community Benefit Trust (KWCBT) needs to collect and use certain types of information about individuals who come into contact with KWCBT in order to carry out our work. KWCBT is what's known as the 'Controller' of the personal data you provide to us. You can contact the Data Protection Officer at info@kilbraurwindfarmcbt.co.uk

# What personal data will we collect?

KWCBT will not collect any personal data about you unless you consent to this. Such information includes data such as your name, telephone number, address or email address.

You must be aware that in many occasions to enable us to provide you with a service we may require certain "necessary information" from you and if you do not provide that information we may not be able to provide you with the service.

KWCBT will process your Name, Address, Email Address and Telephone Number.

## What are the purposes of processing the data?

- In order to keep proper governance records (eg Trustees)
- In order to keep accurate staff records
- In order to keep accurate volunteer records
- In order to keep accurate membership records (Community Council Contact)
- In order to process grant applications
- To provide statistics on to statutory bodies and or funders

KWCBT use personal data for statistical information required by external agencies, government bodies, prospective and existing funders. Personal data will, where necessary, be anonymised to ensure that no identification of individuals is possible.

#### Lawful processing of personal data

KWCBT can process your information because you have given consent.

## What we do with your data

KWCBT regards the lawful and correct treatment of personal information as very important to successful working, and to maintaining your confidence.

KWCBT will ensure that your personal information is treated lawfully and correctly. Information and records will be stored securely and will only be accessible to authorised staff and volunteers.

Information will be stored for only as long as it is needed or required by statute and will be disposed of appropriately.

Your personal details will not be given to anyone outside KWCBT without your consent unless it is necessary for us to do so, i.e. in order to comply with the law, with police investigations or it is determined that there is risk of significant harm to either yourself or another person.

KWCBT may share data with other agencies such as the local authority, Health organisations, funding bodies and other voluntary agencies - in the form of statistics and not in any way that identifies you. You will be made aware how and with whom the information will be shared.



## How long do we keep your data?

Information will be stored for only as long as it is needed or required by statute and will be disposed of appropriately.

### What are your rights?

All Data Subjects have the right to access the information KWCBT holds about them. Individuals may exercise the right by making a written 'subject access request' (SAR). However, subject access goes further than this and an individual is entitled to be:

- told whether any personal data is being processed;
- given a description of the personal data, the reasons it is being processed, and whether it will be given to any other organisations or people;
- given a copy of the personal data; and
- given details of the source of the data (where this is available).

You have the right to receive a copy of the personal information that KWCBT holds about you, and to demand that any inaccurate data be corrected or removed.

You have the right to withdraw consent at any time, where relevant.

If you wish to access a copy of any personal data being held about you, you must make a written request for this. To make a request, please complete a Personal Data Subject Access Request Form which can be obtained from the Data Protection Officer. If a SAR is received KWCBT will respond within one month.

Security precautions in place to protect the loss, misuse or alteration of your information When you give us personal information, we take steps to ensure that it's treated securely. We use an appropriate combination of technical and organisational measures to ensure, as far as reasonable possible the confidentiality, integrity and availability of your information at all times.
